Submission Guide

Required submission files:

1. Project description in the English language (in Word Document Format).
2. Posters, participants must use the provided templates for submission (JPEG Format).

1. Project Description:

A word document contains the project description provided by the participant, the description should not exceed 550 words. This file to be included in the ZIP file that contains all submission materials, the student should describe his/her project **without mentioning their name anywhere in the document**, the word document should be then saved as (Registration Number - Description.doc) in the submission ZIP file.

Example of file name: TIA21-999 Description.doc

2. Posters:

The award has provided two templates to be used for the entries; black and white background templates, students can choose the template with the background suitable for their project as long as they use one set of colours, either white or black.

The templates details are:

- 3 x A1 Sheets (84cm width x 59cm height).
- Sheet 1 (Concept Sheet): Use this space to introduce your research, the local or global challenge you are responding to or the issue this site is facing, your context, a summary of your site analysis, concept and the design process. There are no design constraints for this sheet, students can design it to what they think the best suits their entry.
- Sheets 2 and 3 are divided into 3 main areas (colours are used to show and clarify the areas, Students must remove the coloured areas when finished), and they are:

- a. **Orange Area:** This is a **Mandatory** area, images and required drawings used in this area should have the right dimensions (30cm width x 24cm height).
 - b. **Grey Area:** This area can be used to present any plans, drawings or rendered images. This area can be used to present a minimum of 1 image and a maximum of 8 images (leaving 2cm space between each 2 images).
 - c. **Project Description area:** This area is used to describe the project in the English language with no more than 550 words for both pages. Some students may find it difficult to describe their projects in English but most of the judges of Tamayouz Excellence Award do not speak Arabic or Kurdish for this reason it must be completed in English and it shouldn't be more than 350 words in the first poster and 200 words in the second poster.
- Scales of all drawings should be written in the provided areas, students can use any scale they see suitable to present their project.
- After typing the Project Title in the provided Line, putting images and drawings in the orange and grey areas, describing the project and WRITING THE REGISTRATION NUMBER in the provided area, SAVE the posters as 3 JPEG files (**150dpi**), these files should be named (Your Registration Number – P1), Poster name example: TIA21-999 – P1, TIA21-999 – P2 and TIA21-999 – P3

MAKE SURE YOUR NAME IS NOT MENTIONED ANYWHERE ON THE POSTER OTHERWISE YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED WITHOUT NOTIFICATION.

Things to check before you submit:

- JPEG Posters and Description document are in a ZIP that is named after your registration number (example: B791.zip).
- All the files have the registration number in the name.
- The size of the ZIP file is not more than 30MB
- Your name is not mentioned anywhere in the submission.
- Upload your project to the submission link in your registration email.
- **Please don't upload your project more than once.** It may confuse us and we may lose your submission.
- Each Participant will receive a confirmation of receipt after they upload their submission.
